WHAT IS REGGIE'S GIFT?

Reggie's Gift was founded in loving memory of Reggie Renouf, who passed away in 2019 at the age of two, from Infantile Onset Pompe Disease. The program operates through the Australian Pompe Association and provides financial assistance to families who are caring for a child with the same life-limiting illness.

We understand that having a child with a severe, complex medical condition can bring significant emotional and economic hardship. Our mission is to support and enrich the lives of families who have a child with Infantile Pompe Disease, by providing financial aid which is flexible and unconditional.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

In order to be considered for Reggie's Gift, applicants must;

- Be the primary carer/guardian of a child who is under 18 years of age and has a confirmed diagnosis of Infantile Pompe Disease
- Be an Australian Citizen or permanent resident
- Be a member of the Australian Pompe Association (exceptional circumstances considered)

Applications are not means tested, nor does Reggie's Gift dictate how financial support should be used as we recognise each family's needs and priorities will differ.

Families are welcome to submit an application to Reggie's Gift annually if meeting eligibility criteria.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete all sections of Reggie's Gift application form
- Attach a supporting letter from the child's primary treating medical specialist
The letter should be on official hospital letter head and include;
 - o Confirmation of the child's name, age and address



- Confirmation of the child's primary carer/legal guardian and their Australian Citizenship/or permanent residency
- Confirmation that the child has been diagnosed with Infantile Onset Pompe Disease
Additional medical information to support the diagnosis is optional and at the discretion of the treating medical specialist
- Provide full name, position, provider number and signature of treating specialist
